- 4:00 PM** First wave of guests arrive
- 5:30 PM** Second wave of guests arrive
- 7:30 PM** Third wave of guests arrive
- 7:30 PM** Dinner is served in the Dining Hall
- 9:00 PM** Campfire and/or another guest-led activity

Saturday

- 8:30 AM** Breakfast is served in the Dining Hall
- 9:30 AM** Sign-up for morning activities
- 12:30 PM** Lunch is served in the Breezeway
- 1:30 PM** Wedding party gets ready; low-key activities for guests
- 3:00 PM** Ceremony

OUR FACILITIES

The Outdoor Chapel

Winding down a narrow path behind the Dining Hall towards the ocean, guests will find themselves at the outdoor chapel. Two massive old growth Cedars mark the entrance to a serene wooded clearing.

Benches

Overlooking the Howe Sound, tucked at the end of a short path, is a beautiful terraced bluff called simply, The Benches. Guests can stand on the terraces taking pictures of the ceremony while the bride and groom stand safely near the edge of the bluff.

The Promontory

Adjacent to the Pavilion and overlooking Canoe Cove & Halkett Bay, the Promontory provides couples with a stunning BC backdrop for their outdoor ceremony.

One of the favourite spots for wedding ceremonies, the main field in front of Jubilee Hall looks onto the Howe Sound and the North Shore mountains, forming a spectacular backdrop.

The Pavilion



The Dining Hall Field is across the stream from the Main Field and is a perfect spot for a cocktail hour. The tall trees on the east and west sides of the field offer soothing afternoon shade and the close proximity to the Dining Hall means seating at dinner is a breeze.

ACCOMMODATIONS

The Cottage

The larger of our two luxury cabins.

Sleeping: Six bedrooms (one queen room, five rooms with two twin x-long beds each)

Amenities: Kitchen, living room, dining room, three bathrooms, and a deck with a barbecue

Includes: Central heating and a wood burning stove

Max Capacity: 12

The Farmhouse

The smaller of our two luxury cabins.

Sleeping: Two bedrooms with queen beds, as well as a pull-out double size sofa bed in the living room

Amenities: Open concept kitchen, dining, and living room, one bathroom, and a deck with a barbecue

Includes: Central heating and a wood burning stove

Max Capacity: 5

Craigcroft

Our dorm-style building with a huge and yet cozy common area.

Sleeping: 12 bedrooms (6 upstairs and 6 downstairs; 11 rooms have a bunk bed and single bed, 1 room has two single beds)

Amenities: Open concept kitchen, dining, and living room, two bathrooms (one with a baby change table), and a deck with a barbecue

Includes: Central heating and a wood burning stove

Max Capacity: 35



ACCOMMODATIONS

Sibley Tents

Rustic canvas tents for a true camping experience.

Sleeping: Six vinyl mattresses per tent; six tents total

Amenities: Double entrances, air vents, access to communal bathrooms

Note: Sibley Tents are unheated and have no electrical access; available from May to mid September

Max Capacity: 6 per tent

Cabins

The classic summer camp accommodation.

Sleeping: Eight bunk beds per cabin; (2 in semi-private 'Counsellor Room' four cabins total)

Amenities: Arranged in duplexes in central location, with access to communal bathrooms and electricity

Note: Cabins are unheated, but can heat up nicely with space heaters in the shoulder season.

Max Capacity: 16 per Cabin

Honeymoon Sibley

A private tent for a newlywed camping experience.

Sleeping: Queen sized bed

Amenities: Double entrances, air vents, access to communal bathrooms

Note: Sibley Tents are unheated and have no electrical access; available from May to mid September

Max Capacity: Wedding Couple



ACTIVITIES

Camp activities will be led by Camp Fircom staff on Saturday for guests. These activities may include:

Our Buy-Out Fee is for site exclusivity and is dependent on your selected wedding date

\$21,000.00	May 16 - June 30 (175 beds)
\$23,000.00	July 1 - September 15 (175 beds)
\$19,000.00	September 16 - October 15 (148 beds)

Catering:

Options available and meal prices per person will be confirmed by January 31st of the year that the wedding takes place.

Payment:

- 1st non-refundable deposit of \$3,000 upon booking.
- 2nd non-refundable deposit of \$8,000 by Nov. 30, 2024.
- 3rd non-refundable deposit of \$8,000 - \$12,000 by April 1st, 2025. (3rd deposit is dependant of Buy-out fee rate).
- The outstanding balance will be paid after the event.

Q&A

Getting Here

Camp Fircom is located on Gambier Island, which is in the Howe Sound region of British Columbia. All guests must arrive by water taxi, which is booked by the couple. Please contact [Cormorant Marine](#) or [Mercury Transport](#) for prices and more information. Private boats are not allowed at Camp Fircom, as we do not have moorage available.

Tours

Camp Fircom will organize a tour of the property for all interested couples. The tour is free for the wedding couple only, any extra guests will need to pay for return water taxi transportation. *Please contact us for more information.*

Weather

Located on the stunning West Coast, Camp Fircom can experience unpredictable weather patterns. We will be happy to assist with last-minute changes to covered ceremony and reception spaces if needed.

Music

Couples are asked to bring their own music (iPod, DJ or Band). A speaker system with a full sound mixing board will be available to the wedding party. Out of respect for our Gambier Island neighbours, amplified music must end at midnight – no exceptions.

Garbage & Recycling

Camp Fircom is an off-grid facility. Without city-provided waste management services, we are responsible for disposing of our own garbage & recycling.

To reduce the load on our systems we require Wedding Couples to take their own garbage & recycling (including refundables) off island with them.

Tastings

Camp Fircom offers one annual wedding tasting in early spring. All couples that have booked a wedding in that calendar year are invited to attend and may sample a variety of options from the Event Menu. Tastings are \$150/person and include water taxi fare. During this time, our Hospitality Director will host an in person Q&A session as well.

Catering Selection

Prices per person may fluctuate and meal choices may vary based upon food costs charged by our service providers and availability of specific menu items. Meal prices per person will be confirmed by January 31st of the year that the wedding takes place.

The catering package (per person) includes: Friday Dinner, Saturday Breakfast, Lunch, and Reception Dinner, and Sunday Brunch. This amount can vary based on the package choice. Catering packages for children 7 and under are half price.

Alcohol & Bar Service

All couples will provide their own alcohol. Fircom will provide a Bartender for Friday and Saturday afternoon/evening, who will obtain Liquor Event Licenses for both days on the Wedding Couple's behalf.

The fee for the Bartenders services, as well as the fees for the Liquor Event Licenses, are included in the wedding buy-out fee.

Décor

Flowers and the vast majority of décor must be brought to camp and set up by the wedding party. Couples will also be responsible to take down all the decor and flowers they have set up on arrival day.

Childminding

Camp Fircom offers a Childminding service on Saturday night for an extra fee. Childminding is intended to allow parents to leave their accommodations after the children are in bed. A staff person will be present in the building and will maintain a calm and safe atmosphere for sleeping children. The staff will alert parents if they need to return to their accommodation to cater to the needs of their children.
